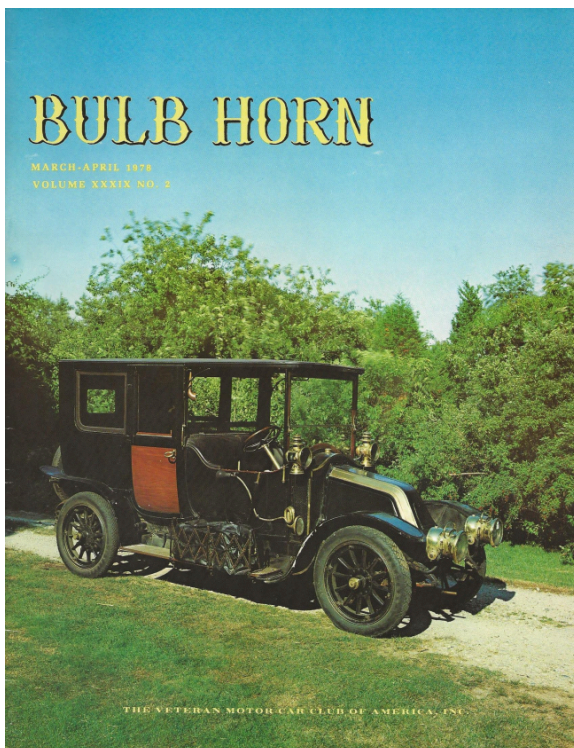

The Journeys That Lie Ahead



I ventured into the Maxfield archives of all things car related in search of inspiration for a message for the Touring Chronicle. One could spend a great deal of time there, similar to going through the stash of old pictures. I started with Ray and my initial introduction to VMCCA and our membership. I discovered our original Membership Certificate, dated April 21, 1978. Included in the packet was a welcome letter with a VMCCA decal and membership cards attached, a March – April 1978 Bulb Horn magazine, Membership Application, Membership Directory and an Index to the 1977 publications of the Bulb Horn which were created in Volumes rather than dated issues.

Interesting fact, in the early formation of the club, members were kept up to date with the club by Bulletins, the first of which was sent in March 1939.

A few interesting things I found in that 1978 Bulb Horn magazine.

- 1978 Western National Tour – Rendezvous at Jackson Hole – August 21-24, Hosted by the Eastern Idaho Chapter, Bonneville Region. Tag line: It's Going to be a Great Week – So Join the Clan in Jackson at Rendezvous Time!

- Announcement of the 33rd Revival Glidden Tour® September 17-22, in the Pocono Mountains of Eastern Pennsylvania. Special notes on the announcement: This will be the ONLY announcement of the Pocono Glidden Tour. NO announcement will be sent by mail. Tour is limited to 300 cars model years 1934 and older. The application you are requesting now will be mailed the end of May 1978 and then the First 300 returns will be the Tourers. Those who “pre-applied” during the 1977 Georgia Glidden need not write now but

must return the May mailing as quickly as others. They registered 354 cars, 800 people.

▪ An article on the Fortieth Annual Meeting (1977), January 28, 1978 in Tampa, Florida. A portion of the article talks about a Wives' Tour to *The Hawaiian Village* for a relaxing day of shopping and sightseeing. It appears an entire day was devoted the ladies with a couple of sightseeing venues and lunch at the Innisbrook Golf and Country Club.

Although some things have changed over the years in the way we do things, the encouragement is still to keep planning exciting tours for our members. It is fun to look back, observe what's been done in the past, and consider locations for a tour. A novel idea, recreate a tour from the past. Old Bulb Horns give us an amazing tour history.

MOUNTAIN & PLAINS REGION TOUR



BUFFALO, WYOMING



JULY 8-11, 2026



Buffalo, Wyoming (pop. 4,415) is a quaint mountain town at the foothills to the Bighorn Mountain Range. At an elevation of 4,708 feet, Buffalo is located almost equal distance from the South Dakota Black Hills and Yellowstone National Park. This area is also the home and setting for books by novelists C. J. Box and Craig Johnson. Johnson's books were also the basis for the *Longmire* television series.

Day 1 will be a relatively flat drive to Gillette, Wyoming. This area is known for its open pit coal mines. We will take a bus trip from Gillette to the Eagle Butte Coal mine. We will also take in the Frontier Auto Museum.



Day 2 we will tour from Buffalo over the rugged "Bighorn" mountains to Worland and the Washakie Museum and Cultural Center. The Center features history from ancient mammoth hunters through early settlers. We will have lunch in Worland. Then we will go on to Thermopolis where there are thermal hot springs swimming pools(2) and a Hot Springs Bath House. Bring your swimsuit! The park has attractions of buffalo and walking trails around hot water springs. Also in Thermopolis is a dinosaur museum. The elevation at Buffalo is almost 5,000' above sea level and we will travel to nearly 10,000' enroute to Worland. Our return to Buffalo will be by the route we came.

Day 3 Saturday's first stop will be at Yoders Amish Country Market. We will then progress to Kaycee, Wyoming, and the Hoofprints of the Past Museum. Johnson County was the scene in 1892 of a cattle war between the large cattle barons and small ranchers trying to make a start. Kaycee was the home of country singer Chris LeDoux where a park is named in his honor.



Other points of interest and side trip possibilities include: Custer Little Bighorn Battlefield, 104 miles away; Mountain Meadows Wool Mill in Buffalo, Wyoming; Fort Phil Kearny Historic Site, 16 miles; Occidental Hotel/Bar in Buffalo; Bombshell Cantina Brewery In Buffalo; Range War Rodeo (Thursday)at the fairgrounds— free admission.

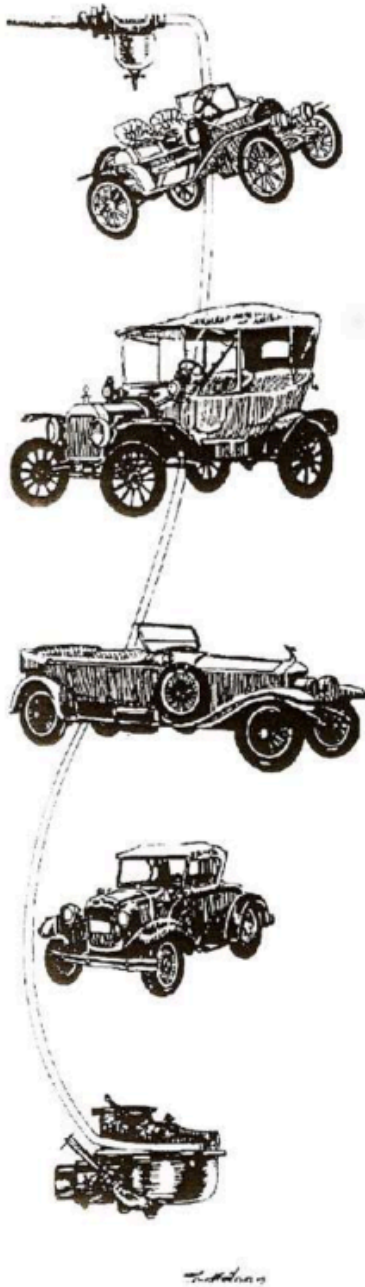

A Brief History on the Product Miniature Company

During the post-war period, many toy car manufacturers were producing miniature, replica vehicles for a market that included the automotive industry, the hobby enthusiast and the toy stores as well.

During the late 1940s to 1950s, the Product Miniature Company – located in Pewaukee, Wisc. – was the main supplier for International toy trucks along with Chevrolet promotional model cars. Essentially, the Chevrolet brand's latest model line was available to customers in miniature form around the same time new vehicles were being introduced to new customers.

The Product Miniature Company, or PMC, was founded by two brothers, the late William and Paul Ford, in 1946. At the time, other toy car manufacturers were already established businesses such as Chicago-based Banthrico and JoHan Models, located in Detroit. Other companies at that time were National Products and AMT.
